CALL FOR PAPERS

As you may know, we have postponed our **Annual International Conference on the Psychology the Self** scheduled to be held in Berlin until 2009, at which time all of the particulars of the original conference will be presented, including the theme and the location in Berlin.

We are pleased to announce at this time that we are rapidly moving ahead on our plans for this year's Annual Conference on The Psychology of the Self which will be located, most likely, on the Eastern seaboard. The Conference title will be *“Self Psychology Explores the Development of Individuality.”* and will reflect on the following theme: The analyst and analysand can stand alone as well as relate to others: A reexamination of narcissism, autonomy, and individuality in light of the power of intersubjectivity. Plan to join us for an exciting conference featuring Pre-Conference Workshops and Master Classes, as well as major Panel Presentations, Faculty and Audience Discussion Groups, and Original Paper and Workshop sessions.

The International Council of the International Association for Psychoanalytic Self Psychology invites all interested professionals to **submit papers** for consideration of inclusion in the **Workshops and Original Paper Sessions** at this conference. Papers and workshops must be **relevant to Self Psychology**. These workshops and paper sessions are scheduled for one and one-half hours, which will include the actual presentation and a discussion by a faculty member and the audience. The first draft paper may be **up to 18 pages, double-spaced**, with the font to be no smaller than 12 point, and with 1 _ inch margins on all four sides. If your paper is accepted, we will ask that the final presentation be limited to 30 minutes.

***** Paper Submission Process *****

The **deadline for submitting your paper is Tuesday, April 15, 2008**. No names are to appear on your paper and abstract. Please submit your paper via email attachment sent to iapsp@pcmisandiego.com. If mailing your material, please still send an electronic submission.

In addition to your paper, **please submit the following materials:**

1. Call for Papers **Cover Sheet** (Page 2)
2. One Paragraph **Abstract** and One **Educational Objective** for your presentation (“At the conclusion of my presentation, the participant will be able to: (describe, explain, illustrate...)”
(Items should be on the same page and must be typed.))
3. Brief **Curriculum Vitae** (no more than 2 pages)

Due to accreditation application requirements, all of these materials must be submitted in order for your paper to be reviewed. We regret that papers submitted *without* all of the above items **cannot be considered** for review. All submitted papers will be reviewed by the Program Committee. Authors will be notified of the Committee’s decision by **mid-May 2008**. Paper and Workshop sessions are limited by space availability.
